the sulcata tortoise *Centrochelys sulcata* also known as the african spurred tortoise is one of the most popular and recognizable tortoise species in
captivity as the third largest tortoise species in the world it is known for its impressive size resilience and strong personality sulcata tortoises are
native to the arid regions of africa where they have adapted to survive in harsh desert conditions despite their ability to thrive in the wild they have
become highly sought after in the pet trade leading to an increase in captive breeding owning a sulcata tortoise is a long term commitment as these

reptiles can live for more than 70 years and grow to over 100 pounds their dietary environmental and social needs require dedicated care making them best suited for experienced reptile keepers or those willing to invest the time and resources necessary for their well being in this chapter we will explore the sulcata tortoise s background natural habitat and distribution providing a foundation for understanding their care requirements overview of the sulcata tortoise scientific classification and physical description the sulcata tortoise belongs to the family testudinidae and is scientifically classified as *Centrochelys sulcata* it is one of the largest species of land tortoises only surpassed in size by the galápagos tortoise *Chelonoidis nigra* and the alibaba giant tortoise *Aldabrachelys gigantea* sulcatas are characterized by their thick protective shell which is typically a sandy or light brown color that helps them blend into their natural desert surroundings their shell known as a carapace is highly domed and features prominent growth rings on each scute which become more pronounced as they age a distinguishing feature of sulcata tortoises is the presence of large pointed scales spurs on their hind legs which is how they got their common name the african spurred tortoise as hatchlings sulcata tortoises are small typically measuring 1.5 to 2 inches 4 to 5 cm in length however they grow rapidly reaching 10 inches 25 cm within a few years and ultimately reaching an adult size of 24 to 30 inches 60 to 75 cm or more their weight can range from 80 to over 150 pounds 36 to 70 kg with males generally being larger than females behavior and temperament sulcata tortoises are known for their strong personalities and curious nature unlike some tortoise species that are shy or reclusive sulcatas are often active and interactive with their environment they are intelligent reptiles that quickly learn routines and can even recognize their owners however their intelligence and strength can also pose challenges for keepers sulcatas are notorious diggers and can excavate deep burrows sometimes reaching over 10 feet 3 meters in length in captivity this burrowing behavior can be problematic if enclosures are not properly secured additionally they are strong enough to push through fences walls or obstacles in their path making escape proof enclosures essential while they are generally docile and non aggressive male sulcatas can become territorial and engage in head butting or ramming behaviors particularly during the breeding season this behavior is primarily seen in interactions with other tortoises but can sometimes be directed toward inanimate objects or even their owners lifespan and growth rate one of the most important considerations for potential sulcata tortoise owners is their long lifespan these tortoises commonly live 50 to 70 years with some individuals exceeding 100 years in optimal conditions due to their longevity owning a sulcata tortoise is a lifelong commitment that may even require planning for their care beyond a single generation of ownership

species of tortoise in the world surpassed only by the galápagos tortoise *chelonoidis nigra* and the aldabra giant tortoise *aldabrachelys gigantea* among mainland tortoise species the sulcata holds the record for being the largest native to north central africa particularly the southern edge of the sahara desert sulcatas are well adapted to extremely dry environments their name sulcata refers to the deep grooves or sulci that run across their legs and shells these grooves or spurs give them their alternate common name african spurred tortoise taxonomic classification kingdom animalia phylum chordata class reptilia order testudines family testudinidae genus *centrochelys* species *centrochelys sulcata* 1 2 natural habitat and environment sulcata tortoises are indigenous to the sahel region a transitional ecological zone that lies between the sahara desert to the north and the savannahs of sudan to the south this region stretches across multiple african countries including chad mali sudan mauritania senegal and niger the sahel is characterized by arid to semi arid conditions sparse vegetation scorching daytime temperatures cooler nights seasonal rainfall to survive such an extreme environment sulcata tortoises have developed numerous adaptations burrowing behavior to escape the daytime heat and maintain hydration tough domed shells that provide protection and thermal regulation efficient water conservation storing fluids in their bladder and reabsorbing it during drought a diet consisting primarily of dry grasses and fibrous vegetation making them exceptionally well suited for low nutrient ecosystems their instinct to burrow often creating tunnels up to 10 feet deep is key to their survival these burrows remain cooler and more humid than the outside air protecting the tortoise from dehydration and heatstroke 1 3 physical characteristics the sulcata tortoise is one of the most striking and recognizable tortoise species due to its impressive size and unique features size and weight hatchlings around 2 inches in length and weigh approximately 50 grams adults can grow up to 24 to 30 inches long weight adult males often exceed 100 pounds with females typically slightly smaller shell carapace light brown tan or sandy yellow dome shaped with clearly defined scutes grows increasingly rugged and marked with growth rings over time

the sulcata tortoise *centrochelys sulcata* commonly known as the african spurred tortoise is one of the largest tortoise species found in africa it is well known for its large size unique appearance and long longevity adult sulcata tortoises can measure 70 to 100 pounds 32 to 45 kg or more with some measuring 24 to 36 inches 61 to 91 cm physical characteristics shell the sulcata tortoise s shell or carapace is high domed with pronounced growth rings and yellowish brown to tan colors the scutes scales on the shell are strongly ridged contributing to their distinct look body they have strong muscular limbs that allow them to burrow and move quickly across their desert environment head their head is small in comparison to their body with large expressive eyes and a beak like mouth designed for their herbivorous diet lifespan sulcata tortoises are long lived reptiles often reaching 50 years or older in captivity with some living into their 70s or 80s with good care this lifespan requires a long term commitment from pet owners behavior sulcata tortoises are mostly solitary animals however they can be housed in groups if enough space is supplied they engage in actions like sunbathing excavating and seeking for food their attitude is usually placid making them ideal pets among reptile aficionados natural habitat and range sulcata tortoises are native to the sahara desert s arid grassy regions as well as sections of sub saharan africa particularly senegal mali niger and sudan habitat characteristics climate they thrive in hot arid areas where temperatures often exceed 100 f 38 c during the day and drop greatly at night they
